**INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES ATTENDING THE 10<sup>TH</sup> APPC**

**VENUE:**

The conference will be held at the main (North) campus of Charles Sturt University which is located in Boorooma Street, North Wagga Wagga.

*N.B. although the conference is being hosted by the Riverina Conservatorium of Music which is located on the South Campus of Charles Sturt University, all of the conference sessions and on-site accommodation are located at the main (North) campus.*

You will need to allow approximately 10 – 15 minutes travelling time from the CBD or from Riverina Conservatorium of Music to the main campus of CSU and at least 25 minutes travelling time from the airport to the main campus.

Wagga Wagga can get very cold in July with average temperatures for July ranging from approximately minus 2 to 13 degrees Celsius. The conference facilities and on-site accommodation is all heated. We recommend that delegates bring warm clothes with sufficient layers to allow for the cold conditions and the heated conference and accommodation facilities. We would also advise bringing an umbrella and suitable footwear should we experience wet conditions.

**Clothing for the Dalcroze Eurhythmics Presentation:** Participants attending the Dalcroze Eurhythmics session presented by Ms Paula Melville-Clark are advised that they should wear loose fitting clothing and bare feet of soft shoes for this session.
